RANCHO SIMI RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT ANNOUNCES OPENING OF PICKLEBALL COURTS AT SINALOA MIDDLE SCHOOL

The Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District (RSRPD) is pleased to announce that the pickleball courts at Sinaloa Middle School will be open for community use beginning Monday, December 20, 2021.

The Park District is dedicated to meeting the community's request for additional courts for the increasingly popular sport of pickleball. The District currently offers 14 courts for public play. Sinaloa Middle School offers players 12 additional pickleball courts with expanded usage hours from 4:30pm until dusk on days that school is in session, and from 7:00am to dusk on weekends, during school holidays and throughout summer break. RSRPD will coordinate and post any pickleball court closures due to school events or activities.

The additional courts at Sinaloa are offered through a continued partnership between the Park District and the Simi Valley Unified School District who have worked together for many years in providing programs and activities on school property in order to offer our community access to a wide variety of facilities and sports fields when school is not in session.

Board Chair, Kate O'Brien stated, "On behalf of the entire Board of Directors, we are happy to be able to offer the additional amenities to the community and would like to express our sincere thanks to the Simi Valley Unified School District for partnering with us to make that happen."
