Paying tribute to Martin Luther King Jr.'s legacy and devotion to citizenship through service to others, the Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District is hosting a National Day of Service on Monday, January 16, 2023.

Observed each year on the third Monday in January, the MLK Day of Service is the only federal holiday designated as a National Day of Service with focus on improving your community through acts of service. The event is intended to honor Dr. King's life and teachings and to bring people together of all ages, backgrounds, and abilities.

Park District Vice Chair Josh Gray states, "Our ongoing commitment to community is elevated on January 16th as we host service projects to honor Dr. King's legacy as a day on, not a day off.
