RANCHO SIMI RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT REGISTER NOW FOR ADAPTIVE/INCLUSIVE PROGRAMMING

The Alternative Recreation Program (Alt Rec) provides affordable recreational & social opportunities for individuals with developmental disabilities and/or other disabilities which may have impeded them from participating in other recreation programs year-round.

Alt Rec offers an array of recreational activities for participants from ages 8 years to adult. These programs include recreational bowling every Tuesday at Harley's Valley Bowl, "Over 21 Crowd", a supervised dinner at local restaurants the 1st Friday of each month, a free social dance each month with a live DJ (sponsored by the Simi Valley Elks), "Cook Masters" education in culinary skills and trips once a month.

To register for Alternative Recreation Programs, visit the Districts' website at rsrpd.org and then click on "Alternative Recreation". Most other RSRPD activities are also inclusive to participants. To evaluate and to accommodate your individual needs we ask you to let us know of any requested modification at the time of registration.

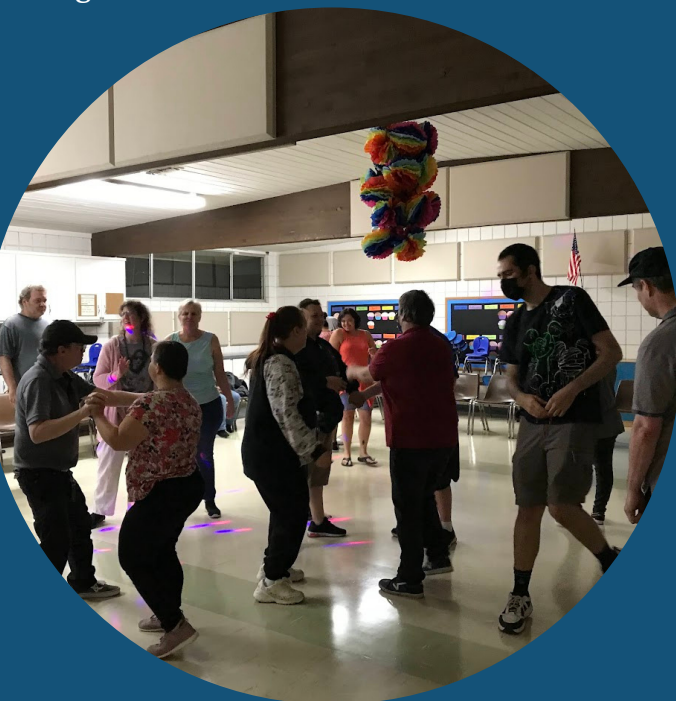

PARTICIPANT

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP POLICY:

All activities are closely supervised, and staff is scheduled according to the individual needs of the program. Participants should not be dropped off early and must be picked up promptly. District policy prohibits staff from transporting participants home. Any participant not picked up within 30 minutes of the conclusion of an activity may be released into the custody of the Simi Valley Police Department.

The reoccurrence of late pick up may be grounds for exclusion from future participation.

REGISTRATION & CANCELLATIONS:

Programs and events have limited space; registration is required 48 hours before each event. Some trips/classes may require more advanced registration as noted in the description. Activities are subject to cancellation if minimum enrollments are not met. Outdoor activities are subject to cancellation due to inclement weather, however make-up classes will be arranged.
