RANCHO SIMI RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT BEGINS ARROYO SIMI GREENWAY TRAIL PHASE 4 CONSTRUCTION

The Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District (RSRPD) is pleased to announce that it has begun construction on Phase 4 of the Arroyo Simi Greenway Trail expansion project.

The contractor, Ardalan Construction of Thousand Oaks, will renovate the paved bike trail on the north side of the Arroyo from Sequoia to Tapo Street, and on the south side from Tapo Canyon Road to Tapo Street. The renovation will also feature upgraded entry gates, signage, benches, and trash receptacles. Rancho Simi Board Chair Josh Gray stated, “We are excited to begin construction on the next phase of the Arroyo Simi. This project will continue the beautification of this stretch of the Arroyo and provide residents with an even safer method of travel throughout the area.”

The project will be completed in three phases to ensure the entire trail remains open during construction. Signs will be posted at specific entrances notifying users of closures. Once construction is complete for each section, it will be reopened for the public’s enjoyment. The phasing details are as follows:

- Phase 1: Currently Underway: The north side of the trail from Sequoia Avenue to Tapo Canyon Road will be closed
- Phase 2: The north side of the trail from Tapo Canyon Road to Tapo Street will be closed
- Phase 3: The south side of the trail from Tapo Canyon Road to Tapo Street will be closed
