Saginaw Charter Township, a municipality of approximately 40,000, is seeking a full-time employee to fill a Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) Operator position at the Wastewater Treatment Plant as part of the Department of Public Services (DPS). Saginaw Charter Township is the hub of Saginaw County, and an integral member of the Great Lakes Bay Region. Located in the heart of the Lower Peninsula, Saginaw Township is only a 30-minute drive from Lake Huron.

The Township has over 210 miles of sewer main; all maintained by the DPS. The DPS also helps to maintain our Township buildings, vehicles, equipment and a vast network of parks and pathways providing high-quality services to our residents.

The WWTP is designed as a 6.48 MGD Oxidation Ditch treatment facility, serving 2 of the 4 sewer districts in Saginaw Charter Township, as well as all of Thomas Township. The WWTP staff also maintains 12 lift stations, a Retention Basin, and a Wetland Treatment Facility (treating a seasonal landfill leachate).

Special considerations for this position will be given to individuals possessing a valid Michigan Driver's License, a WWTP Class D (or higher) Certification in Sewage Treatment Works, from the State of Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE).

Applicants selected for this position will be subject to federally mandated pre-placement and random drug and alcohol testing, as well as physical examination, in accordance with the Department of Transportation regulations. Failure to pass the pre-placement drug and alcohol testing and/or physical examination shall result in Saginaw Charter Township withdrawing the offer of employment or promotion and will subject current employees to disciplinary action consistent with the Agreement between Saginaw Township and the Bargaining Unit. Failure to pass random drug testing after placement in the position will result in disciplinary action up to and including discharge, which is consistent with the above reference agreement.
