


## Accessing e-iNC Library

Prior to accessing e-iNC Library make sure that you have downloaded the OverDrive App and Kindle App on your devices.

- 1) Make sure you access RB Digital from the Sampson Clinton Public Library Site:




**Why should I choose one of these options?**  
These options allow you to sign into the OverDrive app and new OverDrive websites using the same email address or Facebook account.


## 5). To Sign into your library....

- a. Type in your Library Card number without any spaces.  
~Your card # can be found on the back of your card below the barcode.
- b. Then type in your 4-digit PIN#.  
~If you have forgotten you will need to visit the library to reset.  
As well you have the option to select for your personal device to remember your password, so that you will not have to provide your login information in the future.
- c. Finally select sign-in.


6). Once signed in, you can search for titles in the *Search* Toolbar. When you have located your title click borrow.





7). A box will appear with the length of time you may wish to borrow the selected title; select your length of time.

8). Then a *Success* page will occur. You will be asked to choose which method you would like to view your Ebook.



**Please be advised that methods of viewing vary with titles.** The following is a brief description of each format that may be suggested for titles:

- MP3 audiobook- only for audiobooks
- Kindle- can only work if app has been previously downloaded from Google Play or Apple iTunes
- Listen in Browser- allows user to listen without Kindle to their audiobook
- Download Ebook- allows user to download book to device.

9). Once books are checked out, you will be able to retrieve them in your *Loan(s)* tab. At this time the title is ready for viewing.
