Organizations must be members of the Sussex County Chamber of Commerce to join a committee. Committee members must be appointed by the organization's Primary Contact/Administrator of their Chamber membership account. Committee membership is granted by approval. Committee members are notified by e-mail when events are scheduled.

EDUCATION COMMITTEE: develops and sustains short and long-range programs in support of high quality elementary, secondary, and higher education. Examples of programs include educational internship, work study, job shadowing opportunities, college/business partnerships, scholarship support and cooperative education programs.

HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE: shares "Best Practice" ideas and programs which will enhance the ability of local businesses to attract and retain qualified employees. The committee organizes educational programming for the membership to enhance and support business development. *For Human Resource professionals only.*

NON-PROFIT COMMITTEE: helps foster relationships, educate, and provide opportunities to network, share ideas and explore partnerships as well as form collaborative relationships with for-profit chamber members for the benefit of both. *For non-profit organizations only.*

SUSSEX COUNTY TRAILS PARTNERSHIP: committed to a network/connection of parks, trails, and recreational areas to maximize public benefits and responsible use of resources while investing in health and economic vitality. Organizes trail maintenance events and provides maintenance assistance.

TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE: provides information about developments in technology including social media, mobile applications, and cloud computing. The Committee focuses on what businesses need to know to use available technology to enhance business growth and monitors technology-related issues. *For technology-related industries only.*

TOURISM COMMITTEE: works to promote and encourage collaborative marketing efforts through information-sharing sessions. Committee members share individual destination marketing materials and assist in planning tours for media and tour operators. *For tourism-related businesses only.*

WELLNESS COMMITTEE: promotes the physical, emotional, and social wellness and well-being of our business community through education. Wellness is defined by the committee as the balanced interaction of the physical, mental, and social well-being of the individual. *For wellness-related businesses only.*

WOMEN IN BUSINESS COMMITTEE: brings together women from a variety of fields and business environments to provide opportunities for personal and professional growth through networking, leadership and educational programming.

YOUNG PROFESSIONALS COMMITTEE: develops young/junior professionals through business meetings, mentoring opportunities and educational programs, and creates networking opportunities for young professionals to build relationships and reach their full potential. *For persons 40 years of age and under.*
