JOIN A CHAMBER COMMITTEE!

Chamber committees offer an opportunity for members to work with other representatives of the business community to create a better Sussex County for everyone.

EDUCATION COMMITTEE

The Education Committee develops and sustains short and long-range programs in support of high quality elementary, secondary and higher education. Example of programs includes educational internship, work study, job shadowing opportunities, college/business partnerships, scholarship support and cooperative education programs.

EMPLOYER LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE (ELC)

The Chamber, in partnership with NJBIA Employer Legislative Committee (ELC), maintains effective dialogue with state and national legislators on significant pending legislative actions likely to affect County business interests. The Chamber communicates concerns of the County business community to area legislators, and alerts members to pending or possible legislation which could affect County businesses.

HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

The Human Resources Development Committee is a committee for Human Resource professionals only that meet to share Human Resource "Best Practice" ideas and programs which will enhance local businesses ability to attract and retain qualified employees. Organizes educational programming for the membership to enhance and support business development.

The Non Profit committee is a committee to help foster relationships, educate and provide opportunities to network, share ideas and explore partnerships and services and form collaborative relationships with for-profit chamber members for the benefit of both.

SUSSEX COUNTY TRAILS PARTNERSHIP

The Sussex County Trails Partnership is committed to a network/connection of parks, trails and recreational areas to maximize public benefits and responsible use of resources while investing in health and economic vitality.

TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE

The Technology Committee provides information about developments in technology including social media, mobile applications and cloud computing. The Committee will focus on what businesses need to know to use this technology to enhance business growth. The Committee also monitors technology-related issues. This committee is for Technology related industries.

The Tourism Committee is for tourism related industry participants. The committee works to promote and encourage collaborative marketing efforts through information-sharing sessions.
