

Sussex County Schools In Need Of Part-Time/Substitute Nurses

Sussex County Substitute Nurses need either a Standard School Nurse Certificate and valid NJ Registered Nurse License, or a Substitute School Nurse Certificate and valid NJ Registered Nurse License.

If you are nurse, but do not hold any of the above certificates, many Sussex County schools will assist you in applying for your Substitute Credential. The procedure for obtaining your Substitute Credential for the first time is as follows:

New applicants must be fingerprinted through MorphoTrust. The cost is \$65.45 plus an \$11.00 administrative processing fee. Instructions can be obtained through the school upon request.

Applicants must also submit official transcripts that show a minimum of 60 credits completed at an accredited college and applicants applying for a Substitute School Nurse Certificate must also provide a valid RN license.

In addition, a background check, Mantoux Testing and an Oath of Allegiance through your local Board of Education is needed.
