

## **Thursday, June 4, 2020: Restaurant requirements for outdoor dining**

Governor Murphy announced today Restaurant Executive Order Guidance. Some of what was shared is included below. Please review the Executive Order for more details. (Link is listed below)

- Provide Staff Training
- Daily Staff Monitoring to determine illness
- Face Masks and Gloves for all restaurant personnel
- Seating – no more than 8 per table and all tables 6 ft apart
- Menus, condiments, etc... must be disinfected after each use.
- Signage – tape on floors for distance and waiting
- No self-service including buffets, salad bars etc...
- Signage for 6 feet distance – tape on floors etc...
- Signage at entrance requiring guests that if they are ill they are not to enter
- Hand sanitizers for guest use required
- Physical Barriers at reception and cash registers etc... required
- Inform customers that masks are required of the restaurant and proper hygiene is in place
- Masks required by all customers entering inside for payment etc... unless there is a medical reason or under 2yrs of age.
- If numerous guests arrive at one time they must stay in cars and receive a text when table is ready.
- No pagers, beepers etc... allowed.
- Reservations by guests are encouraged.
