AGENCY BUSINESS

• Resolution UR-2022.04 – Downtown Land Acquisition

Staff Report – Community Development Supervisor, Kristi Gilbert – The 0.51 acres of land located at the corner of S. Calapooia and W. Everett is being considered for purchase in the amount of \$279,000. With the location of this property being at an entrance to our downtown redevelopment area, many development opportunities are available. The City's Real Estate Agent has reviewed the information and feels that proposed price is fair and reasonable within the current market. Property owners have agreed to this purchase price.

MOTION made by Sumner to approve Resolution UR 2022.04 – Downtown Land Acquisition in the amount of \$279,000 as presented; second by Hamilton. Discussion:

- > Dagel Where is the money coming from to purchase the land? Finance Director, Tami Trowbridge – Urban Renewal funds which are being borrowed from the City's General Fund. Gilbert added additional information. What will be done with the land? Gilbert – One suggestion made from the Urban Renewal Task Force is for food truck vendors.
- ➤ Groussman Will the current building be demolished? Community Development Director, Brian Elliott Staff's recommendation is to demolish the building due to disrepair.
- ➤ Boggs Was there a public offering for this property? Gilbert The property has been listed for sale for quite some time. Has a cost evaluation been done for a food truck venue? No, per the Agency's previous direction, staff was to research property uses and negotiate a purchase price.
- > City Manager, Jerry Gillham, added further explanation of property use possibilities.
- Dagel expressed disagreement for purchasing this property.
- Groussman expressed agreement for purchasing this property.

Further discussion ensued between Agency Members and staff.

RESOLUTION NO. UR-2022.05

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET ADJUSTMENT, AMENDING THE 2022-2023 BUDGET.

The Sutherlin Urban Renewal Agency finds that:

- A. That ORS 294.473 provides the procedures for public governing bodies to adopt supplemental budget adjustments when estimated expenditures differ by more than ten percent from the expenditures in the budget as most recently amended prior to the supplemental budget adjustment.
- B. The procedure includes the municipal corporation providing notice of a supplemental budget adjustment hearing and holding a public hearing on the supplemental budget adjustment prior to adopting a resolution to change the budget by more than ten percent.
- C. Public notice has been provided as required by ORS 294.473 and a public hearing related to the supplemental budget adjustment was held on November 14, 2022, and
- D. Due to unforeseen events at the time of adoption, fiscal year 2022-23 budget requires adjustment including but not limited to the following:
 - a. Urban Renewal General Fund
 - i. This supplemental budget makes changes based on Agency decisions to move forward with the Everett Street Property Purchase and administration of the Mainstreet Grant for the Historic Bank Building Improvements. Both these items were unforeseeable at the time that the budget was prepared.

NOW, THEREFORE, based upon the above findings,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Sutherlin Urban Renewal Agency as follows:

Section 1. That the budget for the Sutherlin Urban Renewal Agency for the fiscal year 2022-2023, which was adopted by the Agency on June 13, 2022 and is now on file in the office of the City Recorder of the City of Sutherlin, be hereby amended as follows:
