The Urban Renewal Agency is being asked to consider the purchase price of 0.51 acres of land, located in the downtown area, identified as Tax Lots 11000, 11100 and 11200 in Section 17DC of T25S, R5W, Property ID No. R56219, R56212 and R56226.

On May 18, 2022, the Urban Renewal Task Force made the recommendation to the Urban Renewal Agency to purchase the above-mentioned properties located at the corner of S. Calapooia and W. Everett.							
The two property owners of said properties have agreed to the sale price totaling \$279,000. Title Company fees and recording fees with be in addition to the purchase price. With these properties being located at an entrance of our downtown redevelopment, the location of the properties allows for many development opportunities.							
Per our real estate agent, who has reviewed comparable comps of commercial properties, feels that the prices of these properties are fair and reasonable within the current market.

R56219, R56212 and R56226) FOR THE PURPOSE OF REDEVELOPMENT AS ALLOWED IN SECTION VIOR THE SUTHERLIN TAX INCREMENT FINANCE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Sutherlin Municipal Code contains Chapter 2.32 creating an Urban Renewal Agency ("Agency");

WHEREAS, the City Council pursuant to the requirements of ORS Chapter 457 approved the Sutherlin Tax Increment Finance Plan dated June 11, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Section VI of the Plan authorizes certain project activities within the Sutherlin Tax Increment Finance Area; and

WHEREAS, Section VIII of the Plan pertains to acquisiton and ORS 457.085((2)(g) requires properties to be acquired to be included in the Plan; and

WHEREAS, Section VII of the Plan authorizes minor amendments to the Plan and identifying property to be acquired is a minor amendment to the Plan; and


WHEREAS, the Agency intends to purchase the property identified as (Tax Lot 11000, 11100 AND 11200 in Section 17DC of T25S, R5W, Property ID No. R56219, R56212 AND R56226).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Urban Renewal Agency of the City of Sutherlin as follows:

Section 5:	This resolution shall be deemed a minor amendment to the Sutherlin Tax Increment Finance Plan.
