WHAT IS BEING ASKED OF COUNCIL?

Council is being asked to award the contract to Emery & Sons Construction in the amount of \$743,751.00 for the Everett Ave. Pump Station Force Main Improvements.

EXPLANATION

This needed upgrade was approved with the Wastewater Treatment Improvement Project. City of Sutherlin entered into a Mutual Agreement And Order (MAO) on February 11, 2016 with DEQ and the City must complete construction of the new 14" Force Main for the Everett Street Lift Station by no later than November 1, 2017. The new 14" Force Main roughly 3300' in length will eliminate weather related Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSO) which is a violation of the City's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Waste Discharge Permit.

Dear Jerry:

This letter is to recommend action by the City in response to the bids received on January 17, 2017 at 2:00 PM for the above referenced project. Four bids were received, there were no bid irregularities, and all were responsive and responsible. The bids were in the following amounts:

- 1. \$743,751.00 by Emery & Sons Construction Group
- 2. \$787,067.95 by Laskey-Clifton Corporation
- 3. \$833,446.00 by Cradar Enterprises
- 4. \$841,770.00 by Pacific Excavation, Inc.

We recommend that the City take the following action:

- 1. Accept the bids.
- 2. Award a contract to Emery & Sons Construction Group in the amount of \$743,751.00 contingent upon the approval by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) for funding through the Clean Water State Revolving Fund.

It is our opinion that Emery & Sons Construction Group has sufficient experience and qualifications to satisfactorily construct the project.

Contingent upon DEQ approval and assuming the City and Council concurs with our recommendation; we have enclosed four copies of the Notice of Award. A representative for the City needs to sign all four copies after which they should be returned to our office. (Please do not date the Notice of Award.) We will date the Award following notification that the City accepts the bid and is determined to award it.

Pursuant to ORS 279C.835, the Oregon Bureau of Labor and Industries requires that Form WH-81 be filled out by the contracting agency and sent to them with a copy of the first-tier subcontractor form, if applicable (ORS 279C.370), within 30 days of issuing the Notice of Award. The form is available at https://www.oregon.gov/boli/WHD/PWR/docs/wh81.pdf. The Owner is also responsible for payment of a Public Works Fee to the Bureau of Labor & Industries. This payment is accompanied by Form WH-39 which is available at https://www.oregon.gov/boli/WHD/PWR/docs/wh39.pdf.
