Acceptable Items (working or not) ---- basically anything that has a cord or battery ----

Computers*, Printers, Keyboards, Laptops, Hard Drives, Cell Phones, Pagers, Radios, Scanners, Speakers, VCR, DVD, Fax Machines, Answering Machines, Televisions*, Stereos, Furnaces, Water Heaters, Air Conditioners, Microwaves, Power Tools, Kitchen Appliances, lawn and garden equipment*, etc.

- *CRT Computer Monitors = \$5 each
- *CRT Television 26" or less = \$30; 27" or greater = \$50
- *Wood Console and Big Screen/Projection TVs = \$50
- *LED/LCD/Plasma TVs are \$20 each
- *Any Freon containing device = \$10 each
- *Lawn and garden must have oil & gas removed

EXCEPTIONS: No smoke detectors, batteries, light bulbs, fluorescent tubes, DVDs, VHS tape.

Event is open to anyone — you do not have to be a resident of Union to participate.
