

Welcome to the City of Union Park System

In order for everyone to enjoy the parks, please obey the following rules:

- Park is open for public use from 6:00AM until a one-half (1/2) hour after dusk.
- Pets must be on leashes (unless inside fenced area at K-9 -n- Kiddos Park) and waste cleaned-up at all times.
- Drive at or below posted speed limit.
- Drive only on paved park roads.
- Park in designated parking areas only; do not park on grass.
- No bottles or glass containers allowed.
- No littering; place trash/debris in receptacles.
- No camping allowed.
- No golfing allowed.
- No hunting allowed.
- No fighting allowed.
- No solicitors allowed.
- No person shall ride a bike, skateboard, roller blade, etc into or on any pavilion, gazebo, dock, bench, playground equipment or on any other structure within the parks.
- No smoking (vape/e-cigarettes included) and/or tobacco use at or within 25 feet of athletic fields, bathrooms, concession stands, docks, gazebos, pavilions, playgrounds, pool, splash park and structures within those areas previously mentioned.
- No person shall swim, dive or wade in any lake, pond or stream within any park.
- No person shall ice skate on any lake, pond or stream within any park.
- Fires may only be built in provided receptacles intended for the purpose of fire; i.e. grills.
- No person shall damage or deface any park property.
- No person, while in the park, shall unreasonably and knowingly disturb the peace of another person, as stated in The Municipal Code of the City of Union, Section 215.290.
- Other rules and regulations apply as stated in The Municipal Code of the City of Union, Chapter 245.
- All persons, while in the park, shall obey all ordinances as stated in The Municipal Code of the City of Union and all statutes of the State of Missouri.
- Permits for use of specific areas in a park may be obtained through the Park Office.
