
Introductions: Introductions were made around the room, each sharing his or her group affiliation where appropriate. Addie Helmick provided the new name for WAIC (Women's Aid in Crisis): Centers Against Violence.

FRN Director's Report: Lori announced that during Children's Festival on 9/14/19, FRN will have a "cool down" tent or quiet zone. Debora Brockleman added that she would like to see more organizations participating than have registered to date. Lori also noted that Trunk or Treat will be held October 30<sup>th</sup> from 6:30-9:00 pm. At the Foster Care/Adoption Support Group's first meeting on July 30<sup>th</sup> we had 5 families present and 5 or more volunteers. Sarah Campbell spoke briefly today about the Healthy Grandfamilies Initiative; a training for facilitators will be held August 29<sup>th</sup>. Tina Helmick, CSM with DHHR for Lewis, Upshur and Braxton Counties, informed us that there are many "kinship" providers who are fostering children in WV, some of which are not related to the child but have some sort of an established relationship with that child (e.g. teachers). She added that the Family First Prevention Services Act came into being in February, 2018. DHHR is doing more preventative services in an effort to keep families together. Lastly, Lori distributed flyers for the Fall family social dates.

Guest Speaker: Kathy McMurray, executive director of Mountain CAP, provided some preliminary results of their Community Needs Assessment which is conducted every 3 years in Upshur, Braxton and Webster Counties, to determine the needs of low income people.
