

On November 9, 2020 the 26th Judicial Circuit Community Corrections Board held their regular scheduled board meeting at the Upshur County Day Report Center at 6:00 P.M.; all motions were approved unanimously. They approved to give the following employees each a \$2.50/hr pay increase; Cheyenne Troxell, Tom Posey, Samantha Ribeiro Matos, Shannon Helmick, Kelly Bowyer, and Cory Elliott. The increase is to take effect immediately and be paid out of the Community Corrections Fund. Community Corrections is collecting an average of \$40,000.00 per month in DHHR fees which has been the trend for the past 6 months. If we continue to do well with DHHR we will profit around \$480,000.00 in a 12 month period from DHHR fees alone. This is a huge success for the Day Report Center and has never been done in our 15 years of operation, but also puts us at risk of receiving less grant funding so we have to show more spending as we continue to grow. I realize that some of you may be leaving office on December 31, 2020. I want to thank you for your service and commitment to your constituents and remind you of this code section.

§7-7-7a. Limit of budget expenditures.

- (a) No county clerk, circuit clerk, joint clerk of the county commission and circuit court, if any, sheriff, county assessor or prosecuting attorney may, without the approval of the county commission, spend or obligate, before the end of the calendar year, more than fifty percent of the funds allocated for his or her office in the fiscal year budget, in any fiscal year where the person holding the office is leaving office due to either resignation or the results of an election.
- (b) As used in subsection (a) of this section, "spend or obligate" includes, but is not limited to, increasing employee salaries to a level that would create a deficit in the budget if paid during the remainder of the fiscal year in addition to other anticipated expenditures.




