Brushy Fork has an existing trailer park with a large number of units.

A new facility has been built on Brushy fork Road to accommodate Pipeline workers with, I understand. 150 locations. What will become of this after the pipeline is done in 3 years, I do not know.

At present, there are a number of residents, primarily from the existing trailer park, who are walking or bicycling in to town.

Plans are progressing for road modification between Corridor H and the Upshur County Airport road; this is the most dangerous part of the Brushy Fork Road for pedestrians and bicyclers because of relative blind spots. This road, I believe, is an official west to south bypass around Buckhannon.

I would suggest exploring the possibility of establishing a bicycle lane on that road project, or establish a walk/bicycle path along the city's utility right of way to the Event Center on Brushy Fork.



Lowes of Buckhannon was represented by Connor Morrow and Dylan Bedford of Altus *via* teleconference. Sam Nolte read the BOER guidelines and each attendee stated their name and title for the record. Mr. Connor and Mr. Bedford were sworn in. Altus reviewed the documents they provided in advance of the hearing including, but not limited to, the Marshall and Swift Cost Manual and Market Value *via* the Cost Approach, Income Approach and Sales Approach. Altus argued that the assessed value for the Lowes property was not in proportion to properties they consider comparisons, such as Wal-Mart.

Mr. Zickefoose was sworn in and explained that he and Mr. McGee had recently visited the property and obtained updated measurements and information related to the improvements. Mr. Zickefoose supported the assessed value and explained that it is a result of the WV State Tax Departments formula that takes into account property characteristics, construction date, grade, quality, etc.

Mr. Connor and Mr. Bedford continued to argue for the depreciation value to increase to 20% from its current value of 10%.

Terry Cutright confirmed that Mr. Zickefoose had assessed all of the surrounding properties fairly and equitably and thus moved to deny the request. Troy "Buddy" Brady III seconded the motion. Mr. Nolte explained that according to State Law, the Assessor is presumed to be correct and the taxpayer has the burden of proving, by clear and convincing evidence, that the Assessor's value is wrong, a certified appraisal of the property is the recommended evidence and that the taxpayer could appeal to Circuit Court.

Having no further business, the Board will stand in recess until 9:00 am on Friday, February 16, 2018.
