Special election to authorize the implementation of additional levies for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2024, July 1, 2025, July 1, 2026, July 1, 2027, and July 1, 2028, in the approximate average amount of \$3,380,000 annually and that the purposes for which funds are needed in order to maintain and improve the instructional programs and the operation of school services in the Upshur County School District, are as follows:

If for any reason all of the funds herein above allocated for any one of the above enumerated purposes is not used for such purpose in any of such five (5) fiscal years, the unused portion of such funds may be allocated by The Board of Education of the County of Upshur, in its discretion and expended for any one or more of the remaining purposes or carried over to future fiscal years and expended for the above enumerated purposes.

The Board of Education of the County of Upshur, in its sole discretion, is hereby authorized and empowered to expend, during the term of this levy, the surplus, if any, occurring in excess of the amounts needed for any of the above state purposes, plus excess collections due to increased assessed valuations for the enrichment, supplementation and improvement of education services and/or facilities in the public schools in the County of Upshur. The actual amounts budgeted, as well as the amounts spent, for each purpose and in aggregate, likely will vary from one fiscal year to the next depending on the realized tax collections and the needs of the Upshur County School District, as determined by The Board of Education of the County of Upshur with respect to each fiscal year. If the amounts budgeted by The Board of Education of the County of Upshur for a specific purpose or purposes for a fiscal year are not able to be spent entirely in such fiscal year, then the unspent amounts may be carried over and spent on such specific purpose or purposes in subsequent fiscal years.

In the event that the amount collected is less than the amounts noted for the above purposes for any one or more fiscal years, for any reason, The Board of Education of the County of Upshur is hereby authorized and empowered to determine, in its discretion, which one or more of the enumerated purposes set forth above shall be reduced for each such fiscal year, and the amount of each such reduction for such fiscal year, provided that the total of all such reductions shall not exceed the amount of such collection shortfall for such fiscal year.

That should additional money be obtained by grant or otherwise from the state or federal government or any other source such additional money may be used either in substitution for or in addition to the amount obtained from this levy.

That should any item in the aforementioned purpose be declared unconstitutional or invalid due to judicial or legislative action, affected funds will be distributed among remaining items of the purpose.

That the proposed years to which such levy shall apply are the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2024; July 1, 2025; July 1, 2026; July 1, 2027; and July 1, 2028. That the total average approximate amount for said purpose or purposes, during the term of the five-year levy, after making due allowances for exonerations, discounts, and delinquent taxes is \$3,380,000 annually or a total approximate amount for the next five (5) year period of \$16,900,000.

The additional levies, in cents per \$100 of assessed value on each class of property, shall be as follows: on Class I property, 9.83 cents; on Class II property, 19.66 cents; on Class III property, 39.32 cents; and on Class IV property, 39.32 cents.

That the separate and aggregate assessed valuation of each class of taxable property within the County of Upshur for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 is as follows: Class I \$0; Class II \$544,272,458; Class III \$512,293,690; Class IV \$155,927,812; Aggregate \$1,212,493,960.

If a majority of the voters approve the additional levies, The Board of Education of the County of Upshur will not issue bonds upon the approval of such additional levies, as provided by Section 16, Article 8, Chapter 11 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended.

SPECIAL LEVY ELECTION
BOARD OF EDUCATION OF UPSHUR COUNTY
May 14, 2024

Special election to authorize the implementation of additional levies for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2024, July 1, 2025, July 1, 2026, July 1, 2027, and July 1, 2028, in the approximate average amount of \$3,380,000 annually and that the purposes for which funds are needed in order to maintain and improve the instructional programs and the operation of school services in the Upshur County School District, are as follows:

Capital Improvements and Preventive Maintenance - Including, but not limited to, safety and security improvements, capital improvements including renovations and major system replacements; general maintenance including materials, roofs, heating/air conditioning, flooring, windows, doors and painting; and other related expenses.	\$1,000,000
Instructional Programs, Supplies, Materials and Equipment - Including, but not limited to, textbooks, library books, essential school materials and equipment; summer school expenses; alternative education program expenses, transition expenses, option pathways/virtual schooling expenses; and other related expenses.	\$650,000
Substitute Employees	\$450,000
Technology Access and Improvements - Including, but not limited to, maintenance and upgrade of fiber connections, routers, and switches; purchase or lease of hardware, software, infrastructure and training; technology specialists and services for the expansion, maintenance, and improvement of the use of technology; and other related expenses.	\$400,000
Extracurricular activities and extended employment agreements	\$360,000
Contracted Services - Including, but not limited to, prevention officers; athletic trainers; bus expenses related to extracurricular activities and field trips; and other related expenses.	\$320,000
Student and Community Related Services - Including, but not limited to, free admission to regular school extracurricular events for all students enrolled in Upshur County Schools with proper student identification; free admission to all Upshur County residents 60 years of age and older to all regular school extracurricular events in Upshur County Schools with a school issued pass; free admission to all active service and veteran military residents to regular school extracurricular events in Upshur County Schools with a school issued pass; to provide student accident insurance for all students enrolled in Upshur County Schools; community support for the Upshur County Library, 4-H and Extension Office and Stockert Youth Center; and other related expenses.	\$200,000

If for any reason all of the funds herein above allocated for any one of the above enumerated purposes is not used for such purpose in any of such five (5) fiscal years, the unused portion of such funds may be allocated by The Board of Education of the County of Upshur, in its discretion and expended for any one or more of the remaining purposes or carried over to future fiscal years and expended for the above enumerated purposes.

The Board of Education of the County of Upshur, in its sole discretion, is hereby authorized and empowered to expend, during the term of this levy, the surplus, if any, occurring in excess of the amounts needed for any of the above state purposes, plus excess collections due to increased assessed valuations for the enrichment, supplementation and improvement of education services and/or facilities in the public schools in the County of Upshur. The actual amounts budgeted, as well as the amounts spent, for each purpose and in aggregate, likely will vary from one fiscal year to the next depending on the realized tax collections and the needs of the Upshur County School District, as determined by The Board of Education of the County of Upshur with respect to each fiscal year. If the amounts budgeted by The Board of Education of the County of Upshur for a specific purpose or purposes for a fiscal year are not able to be spent entirely in such fiscal year, then the unspent amounts may be carried over and spent on such specific purpose or purposes in subsequent fiscal years.

In the event that the amount collected is less than the amounts noted for the above purposes for any one or more fiscal years, for any reason, The Board of Education of the County of Upshur is hereby authorized and empowered to determine, in its discretion, which one or more of the enumerated purposes set forth above shall be reduced for each such fiscal year, and the amount of each such reduction for such fiscal year, provided that the total of all such reductions shall not exceed the amount of such collection shortfall for such fiscal year.

That should additional money be obtained by grant or otherwise from the state or federal government or any other source such additional money may be used either in substitution for or in addition to the amount obtained from this levy.

That should any item in the aforementioned purpose be declared unconstitutional or invalid due to judicial or legislative action, affected funds will be distributed among remaining items of the purpose.

That the proposed years to which such levy shall apply are the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2024; July 1, 2025; July 1, 2026; July 1, 2027; and July 1, 2028. That the total average approximate amount for said purpose or purposes, during the term of the five-year levy, after making due allowances for exonerations, discounts, and delinquent taxes is \$3,380,000 annually or a total approximate amount for the next five (5) year period of \$16,900,000.

The additional levies, in cents per \$100 of assessed value on each class of property, shall be as follows: on Class I property, 9.83 cents; on Class II property, 19.66 cents; on Class III property, 39.32 cents; and on Class IV property, 39.32 cents.

That the separate and aggregate assessed valuation of each class of taxable property within the County of Upshur for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 is as follows: Class I \$0; Class II \$544,272,458; Class III \$512,293,690; Class IV \$155,927,812; Aggregate \$1,212,493,960.

If a majority of the voters approve the additional levies, The Board of Education of the County of Upshur will not issue bonds upon the approval of such additional levies, as provided by Section 16, Article 8, Chapter 11 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended.

All according to the order of The Board of Education of the County of Upshur, adopted and entered into on the 7th day of March, 2024.
