

SPECIAL UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

April 19, 2022

The County Commission of Upshur County, West Virginia, held a special meeting on Tuesday, April 19, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. Kristie Tenney called the meeting to order. Present were: Kristie G. Tenney, Commission President; Terry B. Cutright, Commissioner; Samuel R. Nolte, Commissioner; Carrie L. Wallace, County Administrator and Tabatha R. Perry, Assistant County Administrator. Lois A. Marsh joined via teleconference.

The meeting began with a moment of silent meditation and prayer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. All motions passed unanimously unless otherwise stated.

Kristie Tenney reviewed scheduled appointments and agenda items.

After discussion, on motion by Terry Cutright, seconded by Sam Nolte, the Commission approved the Levy Order and Rate Sheet, Regular Current Expense Levy for FY2023. Carrie Wallace explained that approval of the levy estimate (budget) had been received from the State Auditor's Office on April 4, 2022.

At 10:00 a.m., the Commission reconvened to commence public testing of voting machines for the May 10, 2022 Primary Election.
