

# UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

October 1, 2021

The County Commission of Upshur County, West Virginia, held a special meeting on Friday, October 1, 2021. Kristie Tenney called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m. Present were: Terry B. Cutright, Commissioner; Samuel R. Nolte, Commissioner; Kristie G. Tenney, Commissioner; Dustin W. Zickefoose, Assessor and Carrie L. Wallace, County Administrator/DHSEM Director.

The meeting began with a moment of silent meditation and prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. All motions passed unanimously unless otherwise stated.

Kristie Tenney called the Board of Assessment Appeals hearing with Pringle House LP to order at 9:01 am.

All individuals in attendance stated their name and position for the record. In addition to those listed above, Steve Muscilli, representing Pringle House, attended via teleconference.

After discussion, on motion by Sam Nolte, seconded by Terry Cutright, the Commission approved the 2021 Board of Assessment Appeals Order for Pringle House LP: True and Actual Value = \$1,800,000 and Assessed Value = \$1,080,000. (copy included)
