

UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSION
EMERGENCY MEETING
December 4, 2018

The County Commission of Upshur County, West Virginia, held an emergency meeting at the Upshur County Administrative Annex on Tuesday, December 4, 2018 at 4:32 p.m. Samuel Nolte called the meeting to order. There were present Samuel R. Nolte, Commissioner; Terry Cutright, Commissioner and Carrie L. Wallace, County Administrator. Troy A. Brady III, Commissioner, was not present. The meeting began with a moment of silent meditation and prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. All motions passed unanimously, unless otherwise stated.

The Commission reviewed a Proclamation made by Governor Jim Justice at or around 3:30 p.m. on December 4, 2018, regarding the closure of business on Wednesday, December 5, 2018 as a legal holiday and permitting County Commissions throughout the state to excuse county employees from their work duties without charge against their accrued annual leave. After discussion, on motion by Terry Cutright, seconded by Sam Nolte, the Commission approved the holiday status on Wednesday, December 5, 2018 and the closure of the Upshur County Courthouse, Annex and County facilities.
