Upshur County Public Library Board of Trustees Meeting November 18, 2020

The regular meeting of the Upshur County Public Library Board of Trustees was held on Wednesday, November 18, 2020 at the library. Board members in attendance were Carol Smith, John Haymond, Kenna Leonard, and Katie Loudin. Also in attendance were Paul Norko, Director; Beth Rogers, Assistant Director; and Connie Cutright, Business Manager. Absent was Linda Riegel.

The minutes of the October 21, 2020 meeting were approved on a motion made by Carol and seconded by John.

The financial reports were accepted on a motion made by Carol and seconded by Katie. Connie mentioned that our fund balance is higher at the end of October due to receipt of the 3rd quarter County Commission and Board of Education funds as well as the quarterly GIA funds from the State for our library and all thirteen affiliates.

Carol inquired as to the status of the account through State Farm. Connie stated that the U.S. Bank representative had passed the signature issue on to her supervisors. They have not gotten back to us, it has been almost five weeks. One possible solution would be to have Dennis Xander sign a check to close the account as he is the only person currently on the account that is still in Upshur County. In going through some old documents, Connie said she believes the funds in the State Farm account are donations from Virginia Bly Hoover and Hazel Hoover Snyder to start a trust fund (\$2,000.00) and another \$5000.00 bequeathed to the library upon Virginia Hoover's death. When the funds were transferred from Bank One to Ameriprise, the Friends of the Library transferred \$6,184.22 that they had invested at Ameriprise to the trust fund. When the funds were moved to State Farm in June 2009, it was no longer called a trust fund. Connie also noted that although a federal identification number had been issued to the trust, she has not found any of the original trust papers that have signatures.

Director's Report – see written report Additions:

- We have received confirmation that we were awarded a \$5,000.00 Rotary Grant for landscaping the parking lot.
- The due date for the Strategic Plan has been extended until March 31.
- Paul and Beth will not be visiting Belington tomorrow due to COVID 19 issues.

It was discussed and decided to form a committee to work on the Strategic Plan. The committee will include Katie, Kenna, Paul, Beth, Connie, and a downstairs staff member.

On a motion made by Carol and seconded by Katie, the board approved opening at 11:00 a.m. on December 4th to allow the staff to have a Christmas Brunch.

Paul asked for further guidance as to what metrics we would use to close to the public and go to curbside service. On a motion made by Carol and seconded by John, the following COVID 19 procedures were decided:

- Try to maintain building occupancy limits.
- Create a sanitation station providing hand sanitizer for the public and a notice stating COVID 19 symptoms and to please leave if you are displaying any of the symptoms.
- The Library will remain open unless Governor Justice issues a state wide shut down order and then we would go to curbside service.
