

# SPECIAL UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

July 2, 2021

The County Commission of Upshur County, West Virginia, held a special meeting on Thursday, July 2, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. Kristie Tenney called the meeting to order. Present were: Terry B. Cutright, Commissioner; Samuel R. Nolte, Commissioner; Kristie G. Tenney, Commissioner; Carrie L. Wallace, County Administrator and Tabatha R. Perry, Assistant County Administrator.

The meeting began with a moment of silent meditation and prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Commission met to consider additional emergency ARP funding requests from Hodgesville PSD. The Commission discussed outstanding invoices from Ringers (\$27,745) and Core & Main (\$11,148.50). Carrie Wallace reviewed her conversation with Anthony Woods (WVSAO). After discussion, on motion by Terry Cutright, seconded by Sam Nolte, the Commission approved an additional emergency allocation of ARP funds in the amount of \$38,893.50, pending confirmation from the WVSAO that funds may be allocated/spent prior to release of the final guidance for the funds. In total, the Commission has now allocated \$43,586.50 for Hodgesville PSD. This sum includes \$38,893.50 outstanding invoices and \$4,698 for Shoemaker water tank.

The Commission received project updates and reviewed Administrative business items.

With no further business, on motion by Terry Cutright, seconded by Sam Nolte, the Commission meeting adjourned at 9:12 a.m.
