Questions and Answers

Q1: Are both a Certificate of Insurance with the required amounts stated in Section 9.6, Insurance requirements, of the RFQ as well as a Bond required by the Proposer?

A1: **Intent and General Information Section 9.6.2 Bond Requirements states:**

*A Performance and Payment Bond issued in a sum equal to **one-hundred (100%) percent of the total awarded Contract amount** by a surety company considered satisfactory by the County and otherwise authorized to transact business in the State of Florida **will not** be required from the successful Respondent for purposes of insuring the faithful performance of the obligations imposed by the resulting Proposal and for purposes of protecting the County from lawsuits for non-payment of debts as might be incurred during the successful Respondent's performance under such Contract.*

Performance and Payment Bonds are not applicable to this RFQ. A Certificate of Insurance is required.

Q2: Under Instructions to Proposers, Item 3, Cost Proposal, please confirm that this is required.

A2: **Once the awarded vendor enters into contract negotiations, the vendor will then be required to submit a cost proposal and rate schedule.**

Q3: Is a full fee proposal required or just a rate sheet with appropriate man hours?
