Questions and Answers

Q1: If our firm needs additional space to answer questions in Form 2 may we use them as necessary, or are we limited to 6 pages?

A1: If more space is necessary, please use additional sheets. If the additional sheets exceed the 6-page limit for Form 2 that is acceptable.

Q2: Will The Instructions to Proposers instructs the proposer to submit three (3) original hard copy and one (1) electronic copy. Do you want 3 original copies with original signatures on each form or is one original and 2 copies sufficient?

A2: One wet signature and two copies will be sufficient.

Q3: Referring to 6.5 of the Intent and General Information, “All names shall be printed in ink below the signatures”, does this rule apply to all forms where a printed name line is not present? Is a typed version sufficient?

A3: A typed version is sufficient.
