

STATE OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Wakulla County, Florida (the "Board") has adopted the Emergency Management Ordinance, Ordinance No. 94-38, providing authorization for the designation of a county official to declare a state of emergency where a quorum of the Board is unable to meet; and ,

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 252.38(6)(e) provides authority for the waiver by the Board of procedures and formalities otherwise required of Wakulla County under the circumstance of a local state of Emergency; and,

WHEREAS, there currently exist in Wakulla County emergency conditions as defined in Wakulla County Ordinance No. 94-38; and,

WHEREAS, there is necessity for a prompt and efficient response and recovery in order to safeguard lives and property affected by the local emergency and/or disaster.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 252.38(3)(a)5), Florida Statutes and Wakulla County Ordinance 94-38, as the designee of the Wakulla County Board of County Commissioners I do hereby declare a state of local emergency. This state of local emergency shall be in effect within the territorial boundaries of Wakulla County except where in conflict with an ordinance of a municipality within Wakulla County beginning this day **July 6, 2021 at 08:00AM., and ending July 13, 2021 at 08:00AM.**
