

ORDINANCE NO. 13-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WAKULLA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING WAKULLA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 13-4 RELATED TO THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION PROGRAM AND THE WAKULLA COUNTY HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMITTEE; AMENDING THE COMPOSITION OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 22, 2013, the Board of County Commissioners of Wakulla County, Florida ("Board") adopted Ordinance No. 13-4 establishing a Historic Preservation Program and creating a Historic Preservation Committee ("Committee") to review and make recommendations to the Board on matters related to the designation, regulation and administration of historical, cultural and architectural resources in the county; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 13-4 requires the Committee to be comprised of seven (7) members from specified disciplines; and

WHEREAS, the County has been unable to find seven qualified members interested in serving on the Committee; and

WHEREAS, in order to be eligible to participate in the Certified Local Government program the Committee must have a minimum of five (5) members; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is necessary to amend Ordinance No. 13-4 to decrease the required number of Committee members from seven (7) to five (5).

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Wakulla County, Florida, that:

ARTICLE 1. RECITALS. The above recitals are true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

ARTICLE 2. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 4 OF WAKULLA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 13-4. The Board hereby amends Section 4 of Ordinance No. 13-4, as follows:

SECTION 4. HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMITTEE.

(B) Composition and Term. The Committee shall consist of ~~seven (7)~~ five (5) members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners for staggered terms of four (4) years. Each Committee member shall serve only so long as he/she is a resident of the county. Appointments shall be made on the basis of a potential member's civic pride, involvement in community issues, integrity, experience and interest in the field of historic preservation. To the extent available in the community, the Board shall appoint professional members from the disciplines of architecture, history, architectural history, planning, prehistoric and history archaeology, folklore, cultural anthropology, curation, conservation, landscape architecture or related disciplines. Lay persons who have demonstrated special interest, experience, or knowledge in history, architecture, or related disciplines shall make up the balance of the Committee.

ARTICLE 3. EFFECT. The remaining provisions of Ordinance No. 13-4 shall remain in full force and effect.


ARTICLE 4. CODIFICATION IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES. It is the intention of the Board, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Wakulla County Code of Ordinances, and that the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intent.

ARTICLE 5. SEVERABILITY. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance or any portion thereof, or any paragraph, sentence, or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder hereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

ARTICLE 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Department of State within ten (10) days after its enactment by the Board and shall be effective upon filing with the Department of State.



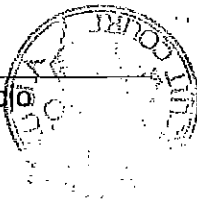


